Double run or Standard format:

Double run format. Swap is available on Friday only. We are offering the option of running an extra round of Chances or Jumpers, but you must give up a jumping round to do so. There is 6 run limit each day.

Entry Limits:

Number of runs is limited to 400 runs per day (350 with jumps)

Move ups:

Move ups will be allowed for both Saturday and Sunday. Trial Secretary must be notified before the end of the trial each day

Day of show Entries:

Day of show entries will be allowed until 8 am each day. The secretary will accept entries for the following day throughout the trial. See confirmation and emails regarding the trial.

Refunds:

No refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal. A withdrawal from the trial after closing date due to bitches in season, an injury and/or illness to the dog or handler will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of your cash and all scrip. A veterinarian's or doctors notice will be required for a refund. If you feel you have circumstances that require a refund that are not due to the above stated reasons, please email the show secretary and your case will be reviewed after the trial. No refunds will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by any cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmations will be sent within a week of secretary receiving your complete payment. If you enter through our on line form and choose to mail your payment, you must mail the payment within a week. You are not entered if the secretary does not receive your payment. If you do not receive a confirmation, please contact the secretary.

Awards and Ribbons:

Placement ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in all jump heights in all classes except Chances which is pass/fail. Qualifying rosettes will be awarded for each qualifying run. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. There will be a 'no-qualifying' raffle each day. Nellie Award will be awarded to the High in Trial novice level dog running in 4 regular classes Sat. and Sun. To qualify for the Nellie Award, your dog must not have any qualifying runs above novice in NADAC.

JUMP HEIGHTS

There are four Standard Division-Proficient jump heights: 8", 12", 16", and 20".

There are four Standard Division-Skilled jump heights: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

There are four jump heights for the Veterans and Junior Handler divisions: 4", 8", 12", and 16".

Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No collars, leads, food, toys, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course. No, food, toys, clickers within 10 feet of the ring. Food or small toys can be in a secure container in pocket during a containerized trial.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. Exhibitor/owner releases NADAC (including its respective officers, directors, employees, and members), **{{Club Name}}** (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and Jefferson County Fairgrounds (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assumes sole responsibility for and agrees to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other person

Cost per run: \$12 or \$14 on Day of Show.

Jr. Handler cost per run: \$6.00

You may pay 20% of your entry with scrip or bit bucks if you choose to enter using our online form. The computer program adjusts your amount owed if you don't pay enough in real money per run. If you do use scrip or choose to mail your payment, the secretary must receive your full payment before you are officially entered in the trial. You can check your bit buck balance from our website. Checks are not cashed until after closing.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE

The fairgrounds are located 17 miles east of downtown Tucson.

From I-10 take Exit 275 for **Houghton** Rd and proceed south for 1-1/4 miles to Brekke Rd. Turn west (right) on Brekke Rd and enter at the Brekke Rd entrance. Follow the signs to the livestock building. The rings will be set up inside this year. Stalls will be available to use for crating your dogs.

RVs

RVs may park and stay overnight at the Fairgrounds. The website for the fairgrounds is: <http://www.the-rvpark.com/Rates.html> According to the website, full service hookup is \$30 and dry camp is \$20. Check the website to see if anything has changed since this printing. Parking is only allowed in the designated RV area and no overnight parking is allowed at the barn. Failure to comply will result in being excused from the show.

SWAP explained in more detail:

Swap (good for Friday only): We are offering the option of running an extra round of Chances or Jumpers, but you must give up a jumping round to do so. You can give up a round of either Regular or Jumpers to gain an extra round of Chances, or a round of either Regular or Chances to gain an extra round of Jumpers. You cannot gain an extra round of Regular, and you cannot run more than **four rounds of jumping classes. If you wish to do this after sending your entry in, you must notify the Trial Secretary by 8:00 am Friday morning.**

Containerized Trial

This will be a containerized trial: no one may leave treats or toys around loose, either at ringside or at their set up. You may carry treats in a container in your zippered pocket when you run. You may not indicate to the dog that you have them nor treat the dog until you are at least 10 feet from the ring.

CLASS CHANGES

If you wish to move your dog up to a higher class you must notify the trial secretary before 6 pm, December 10. Move-ups will be allowed from day to day at the trial within 30 minutes of the end of the class.

Day of Show Entry

Day of show entry will be allowed until 8 am each day. NO day of show entries will be accepted for the current day after 8:00 am. The secretary will accept entries for the following day throughout the trial.

CHECK-IN, Judges Briefing and Start Times

Check-In for measurement for all three days will be at 8:15. You only need to check in once. Dogs running in Skilled and those who have a card on file with us do **NOT** need to check in. **All dogs running in Proficient without a permanent height card must be measured unless running in the 20" or 20+ jump heights or 16" Vet/JH.**
