**You must sign and return the NADAC COVID waiver and SSAC waiver at the end of the premium to be entered in the trial. We will be following Pima County and the city of Tucson guidelines. Currently there is a limit of 50 people allowed on the show site. This may change closer to the show date but be aware we may need to limit the number of people at the show. Anyone not following those guidelines will be asked to leave. There will be no refund. Guidelines will be determined closer to the trial.**

**Crating available:**

Please use social distancing when crating. We will be marking out crating areas.

**Entry Limits:**

500 runs per day.

**Move ups:**

Move ups will be allowed for Sunday. Trial Secretary must be notified before the end of the trial each day

**Day of show Entries:**

Day of show entries for those already at the show will be allowed until 8 am each day. The secretary will accept entries for the following day throughout the trial. **Day of show entries for people not already entered in the trial will be per COVID rules (if we have room for more people at the show site.)** See confirmation and emails regarding the trial.

**Refunds:**

No refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such a dismissal. A withdrawal from the trial after closing date due to bitches in season, an injury and/or illness to the dog or handler will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of your cash and all scrip. A veterinarian's or doctor's notice will be required for a refund. If you feel you have circumstances that require a refund that are not due to the above stated reasons, please email the show secretary and your case will be reviewed after the trial. No refunds will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by any cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. There will be a 'no-qualifying' raffle each day. Nellie Award will be awarded to the High in Trial novice level dog running in 4 regular classes Sat. and Sun. To qualify for the Nellie Award, your dog must not have any qualifying runs above novice in NADAC.

## Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com)
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5. **Saguaro Scramblers COVID-19 Rules, Recommendations and Waiver  
(You must sign and return with trial entry)**

**COVID-19 Rules**

**Saguaro Scramblers USDAA COVID-19 rules have been developed to maintain compliance with current Pima County, City of Tucson and Raven Ranch requirements as well as current CDC recommendations.**

Raven Ranch limits gatherings to a total of 50 people per day. Non-volunteering non-competing guests and spectators are not allowed at this trial with the exception that a guest may come briefly in the morning to help set up your canopy and pack up at the end of the trial. Volunteering non-competing guests are allowed if they volunteer at least 3 classes per day and must be declared in advance on this form or by emailing the trial secretary and will be included in the 50-person limit.

FACE COVERING/MASKS covering both the mouth and nose are required to be worn when an individual cannot maintain a continuous distance of 6' from other individuals. However, individuals traveling together are exempted from this rule when near only each other.

Specifically, face coverings are required during walk-thrus, briefings, during volunteering if continuous social distancing is not possible, in restrooms, near score/secretary tables, and while in designated high traffic area in front of rings. Masks must be worn when approaching another competitor, trial committee, volunteers, or judge unless properly socially distancing.

Face coverings are not required while running your dog in the ring, in your canopy, or while walking around (other than in the marked high traffic area in front of the ring entrances) provided you maintain social distancing.

Disposable masks will be available at the trial for anyone who needs one. Masks are the preferred face covering, but gaiters and bandanas are also acceptable as long as they cover both the mouth and nose.

CANOPIES: Canopies and tents are to be set up with 8' of space in between them. (As stated above, individuals traveling together do not need to wear a mask when together, so a mask is not required while utilizing canopies/tents, unless entering the tent of someone not in your party.)

RULES FOR WORKERS: If volunteering in a job where you cannot maintain at least 6' of continuous social distancing, you are required to wear a mask.

LEASH RUNNING: Leash runners will use a sanitized "grabber" to pick up and carry leashes and wear a mask unless they can continuously maintain a distance of 6' from other people.

Failure to comply will initially result in a reminder of the rules. **Deliberate refusal to comply with these COVID-19 rules will result in expulsion from the trial and that individual must leave the facility immediately with no refund given.**

**COVID-19 Safety Recommendations and Precautions**

- Hospitality will not be provided at this trial, other than water bottles. Please bring your own food and refreshments.

- Please be aware of items that you touch that may have been touched or will be touched by others (e.g., either wear gloves or sanitize hands immediately before and after if you are touching things that are touched by others)

- Avoid touching your face.

- Wash your hands often with soap and water and/or use hand sanitizers (gels, wipes, etc.); please bring your own to assure availability.

- Restrooms are single occupancy and hand sanitizer and soap will be provided.

**Waiver**

If you are concerned about the possibility of exposure to the coronavirus OR if you are unwilling to follow the stated rules, it would be best if you did not enter this trial

I agree that if I am diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the first day of the trial, I will not attend, and can contact the trial secretary for a refund.

I agree to not attend the trial if I am exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, including but not limited to cough, sore throat, fever, and shortness of breath, or have been knowingly exposed to COVID-19 within 14 days of the trial.

I agree that I am attending the Saguaro Scramblers' USDAA agility trial on April 10-11 entirely at my own risk and take full responsibility for my own health and safety during this event.

I agree to follow all event and Raven Ranch requirements, procedures, protocols and guidelines to reduce any exposure and possibility of contracting or spreading the virus. If I deliberately refuse to follow the rules as stated above, I understand that I will be asked to leave and will not be refunded entry fees.

I agree to follow CDC, Federal, State of Arizona, Pima County, City of Tucson guidelines in regard to COVID-19.
